

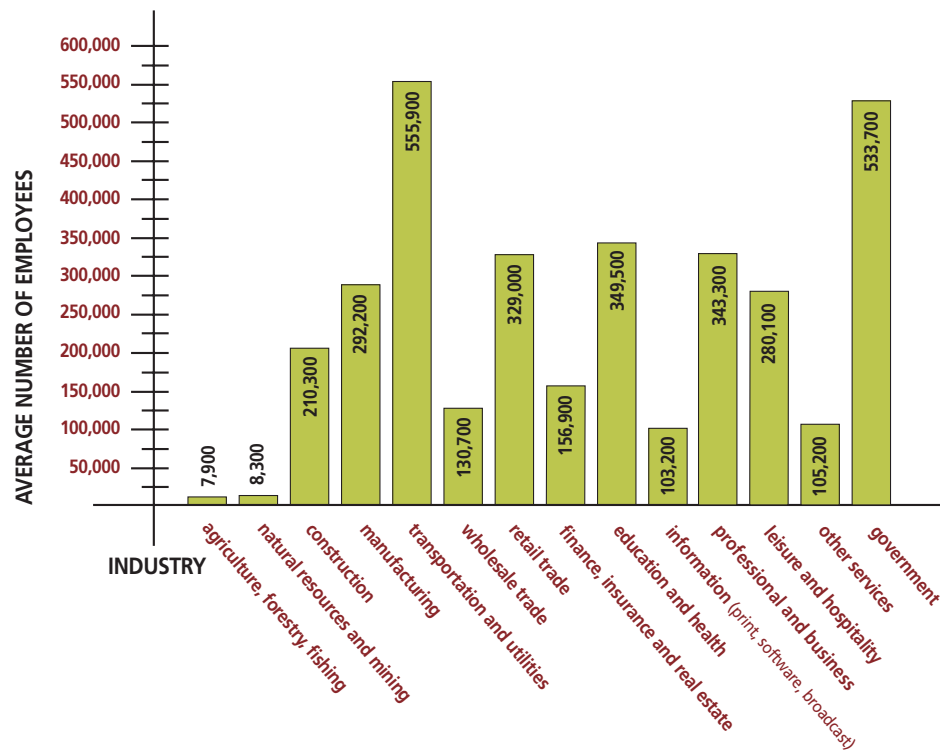
4 1900 – 2000: A century of change

Economic Change

In 1900, about half a million people were counted in the census in Washington. (A census is a count of how many people live here, conducted by the U. S. government once every ten years.) In the 2000 census, nearly six million people were counted. That's a lot of people – and a lot of change for our state.
