VOTER INFORMATION

To register to vote, you must:

- Be a citizen of the United States of America
- Be a legal resident of the State of Washington
- Be at least 18 years old by Election Day

If you move:

Notify the Election Division of the Auditor's Office if you move. This can be done by telephone, mail, or by completing a new voter registration form. To be eligible to vote in a new precinct, a citizen must notify the Auditor's Office of the new address no later than 30 days prior to an election.

Ballots are mailed 20 days before an election. The returned ballot must be postmarked no later than Election Day; the affidavit on the outer envelope must be signed.
