### Bills Needing Action This Week

**SB 5102 Concerning school library and technology programs**, still needs a senator to pull the bill out of Rules to begin the process again in the House. ### Bills Updates

*Bills in **green** are supported. Bills in **red** are opposed by the League. Bills in **black** the League is watching.*

Two bills within the scope of the Local News and Democracy position remain in the Senate Rules Committee. **SB 5626** and **SB 5102** both won Senate approval during the 2023 session but were not voted on in the House, prompting their sponsors to reintroduce them in their present status, returning them to Senate Rules to begin the procedure again.

Regarding **SB 5626**, which would expand and enhance media literacy and digital citizenship: With the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction re-evaluating state Learning Standards, there is some thinking that non-legislative changes may suffice to accomplish the intent of the

original bill. Stakeholders will be reviewing developments in the coming weeks.

**SB 5102**, which concerns school library and technology programs, still needs a senator to pull the bill out of Rules to begin the process again in the House. **Supporters will be encouraged to advocate for SB 5102 once it is back in the House.**
