

Voter Checklist



- I'm registered to vote and all my information is up-to-date.
- My ballot has arrived (soon after October 16, 2020).
- I'm learning about candidates/issues so I can make an informed choice.
- I filled out my ballot correctly and signed the envelope.
- I know where ballot boxes are located and that my ballot must be in the ballot box by 8 p.m. on Election Day, Nov. 3.
- I know I don't need a stamp if I return my ballot by mail, but it **must be postmarked** by Election Day, Nov. 3. Mail it early!

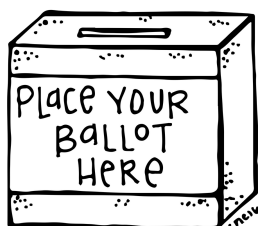
How do I register or check my registration? Go to vote.wa.gov
